## What you need to know about managing termites

The termite management system installed during the construction of your home will deter termites attacking from underground, concealed areas, forcing them to reveal/ expose themselves. Although the termite management system won't stop termites getting into your home, it will make them easier to see. Regular inspections ensure termites which are not deterred by the termite management system will be found and treated. Avoiding regular inspections can be a costly decision with termite damage not covered by household or building insurance.

## Who's at risk?

All houses in Australia are at risk of termite attack. A CSIRO study found that steel framed and masonry houses have virtually the same risk of attack. Termites can also damage plasterboard, carpets, plastics, books, artwork, clothes, electrical insulation and fit out timbers.

## Explanation of a termite warranty

There are two components that relate to the product that is installed at your property. The product warranty and the installation warranty. Cure All Pest Control are the only company that can offer both of these to you.

## What type of termite management system does your house have?

A physical termite barrier was installed, during the construction of your home, by Cure All Pest Control / The White Ant Man. It acts as a physical and chemical termite treated zone, covering the areas of your home, which may be susceptible to termites entering through underground tunnels.

The purpose of having termite protection zone in your home is to ensure that any termites attempting to enter your home will need to do this via the external walls of your home, building their mud tunnels up above ground and making their activity highly visible. This ensures that we can address the termite problem before the termites do extensive damage to your home.

## Location of your Termite Management System

The Termite Management System is usually installed to service penetrations, the perimeter of the structure, piers and driveway cold joints. For further details regarding the location of your Termite Management System, please contact Cure-All Pest Control on (07) 3349 8572.
