Cleaning-Sealing-Maintaining

Porcelain Tiles – Indoor and Outdoor

Instructions for vitrified porcelain tiles with matt or polished finishes

Porcelain tiles are a form of ceramic tile known for being strong and less absorbent. The cleaning, sealing and maintaining instructions are listed in order to give the desired finish and enhance the potential of the tile for the long term.

For Initial Cleaning of Newly Installed Surfaces. More detailed information on other side. NATIONAL TILES RESIDUAL SURFACE CLEANER leaves a clean and clear surface.

NECESSARY EQUIPMENT: bucket, mop and scrubber, squeegee or wet-and-dry vacuum







Dilute in water 1:10



Wipe surface with solution and scrub



Rinse well with diluted mix of ALL PURPOSE CLEANER



Please ensure that tiles and grout are dry before proceeding to sealing.

Protecting Against Stains. *Preferred treatment for new and polished surfaces, turn over for details.* NATIONAL TILES WATER BASED PENETRATING SEALER renders the surface stain and water resistant.

NECESSARY EQUIPMENT: bucket, applicator or roller, brush and cloth



Coverage -1ltr 20 sqm



Pour product into a bucket or plastic tray



Apply with lambs wool applicator and allow to sit for 10mins



Using a clean cloth remove all residue



Allow to dry 2hrs before walking. Protect from water for 24hrs

Regular Maintenance. Additional maintenance tips on other side. NATIONAL TILES ALL PURPOSE CLEANER maintains porcelain surfaces.

NECESSARY EQUIPMENT: mop, bucket





Add 2-3 caps to 3ltrs of tepid water



Wash tiles with solution and allow to dry



Change solution every 50sqm

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Freshly installed surfaces

Grouting remains and glues make initial cleaning more difficult. Firstly clean with *national tiles residual surface cleaner* as described. Synthetic grouting materials can be removed with **Spirit H.D.C.** Cleaner (diluted at a ratio of 1:10, approx. 20mins working time). Scrub using a nylon scouring pad or rotary scrubbing machine.

Cleaning, restoring of exceptionally dirty surfaces

- Prior to treating used surfaces the tile must be thoroughly cleaned. All soiling and care product residues must be removed from the surface of the tiles and grout.
- Dilute Spirit H.D.C. to a ratio of 1:10, apply using a nylon scrubbing pad and allow to sit for 10 minutes, scrub well with a rotary scrubber or brush and wait 5 more minutes.
 Add water to rinse the solution with a mop or wet and dry vacuum.
- Make up a solution of national tiles all purpose cleaner at a ratio of 5 caps to 8 litres water and mop over the floor to neutralise the alkaline in the Spirit H.D.C. then rinse well with water.
- Ensure the surface is completely dry before applying treatment.

Additional Information about Protective Treatments

- Regardless of the density and strength of the tile, stains can develop.
- Always test products in a small hidden area first to check for any adverse reactions between the porcelain and the products used.
- · Follow the detailed instructions on the label.
- Greasy or waxy maintenance products may bind dirt and will affect the slip resistance of the porcelain.
- Sealers are only used on dry surfaces. If not, the sealer will not absorb into the tile properly and will cause abnormal marking.
- Do not allow the product to dry on the surface.
 Carefully remove all excess liquid while still wet. If the product is beginning to dry redissolve with a little more sealer and wipe off.

Tile Tips

Firstly, you can rest easy knowing that National Tiles offers a Lifetime Guarantee on premium range tiles and a 10 year warranty on the majority of other tiles. But there are also some simple tips you can apply to keep your tiles looking smart for years to come.

- Bleach, harsh chemicals, steel wool or wire brushes are not recommended.

 Any harsh cleaning agent may harm your tiles.
- Use only recommended cleaning products and sealants, and make sure they are specific to the tile purchased. The products sold by National Tiles cover every type of tile.
- Spill alert! To avoid grout stains, get onto floor spills straight away.
- Consider using floor protectors on the legs of furniture items to prevent tile damage.
- If your tiles are exposed to underfoot grit the surface can be susceptible to scratching.
 National Tiles recommends use of protective mats at all entry points.
- If you have highly glazed, gloss floor tiles avoid wearing heels.
- Use floor protection products under any furniture which may damage the surface of the tile
- If you're planning on additional tiling through the home it's best to order the tiles all at once so you are receiving a consistant batch of tiles for your home. The life span of tile ranges cannot be predicted by National Tiles.
- Be sure to hold onto the left over tiles from your order incase of any unforseen surcumstances ie. Breakages or plumbing maintentaince.

Cleaning Tiles

What's the best way to care for your tiled floor?
General tile care depends on the type of tiles in your home.
Ceramic and porcelain floor tiles don't need a great deal of aftercare cleaning or maintenance. Regular cleaning is easy using a pH neutral cleaner.

Natural stone on the other hand, needs more care.

We highly recommend that the stone and grout be sealed and then regularly maintained. Stone floors should be vacuumed or dust mopped to remove abrasive agents such as sand or pebbles.

Never use acidic products on your stone floors - clean them with a pH neutral cleaner which you can purchase at National Tiles.
